HOUSING:

Rubbish Monsters aren't fussy. They'll live anywhere you let waste collect up, and they'll spread out too.

What to do?

- Limit your Rubbish Monster's habitats around your home or school.
- ☐ Have their homes clearly labelled or well decorated.
- ☐ Keep you Rubbish Monsters well contained at all times.



TRAINING:

Rubbish Monsters find it hard to behave if they don't make friends with Recycling and Compost Monsters.

What to do?

- ☐ Introduce your Rubbish
 Monster to these other types
 of waste monsters.
- ☐ Have them live nearby each other.
- Teach your Rubbish Monster to share your waste with them.



PROPER NUTRITION:

Rubbish Monsters need to stay small to be easily manageable.

They can also get rumbly tummies from eating the wrong type of food which means they burp and fart lots of STINKY methane gas!

What to do?

- ☐ Feed your Rubbish Monster as little as possible.
- ☐ Make these strict no-go foods:
 - X Type 1 & 2 plastics
 - X Tins and cans
 - Y Paper and clean cardboard (dirty cardboard is "sweet as")
 - ✗ Food scraps and garden waste
 - X Stuff that is flammable, toxic, explosive, corrosive, or radioactive
 - **✗** Old clothes
 - **X** Glass
